# HADDINGTON ATHLETIC - ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION

# Directions: Travelling east on the A1 dual carriage way:

Leave A1 dual carriageway at 1<sup>st</sup> Haddington junction

Carry on to the 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout and take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit towards the town centre following the B6471

Turn Right at Knox Place traffic lights (Railway Hotel) onto the A6093 signposted for Pencaitland

Take 2<sup>nd</sup> road on the left – Meadow Park (200mtrs)

Carry on for 500mtrs before turning left for the HAFC clubhouse and parking area.

## Directions: Travelling West on the A1 dual carriage way:

Leave A1 dual carriageway at 2<sup>nd</sup> Haddington junction

At the roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit towards the town centre following the B6471

Turn Right at Knox Place traffic lights (Railway Hotel) onto the A6093 signposted for Pencaitland

Take 2<sup>nd</sup> road on the left – Meadow Park (200mtrs)

Carry on for 500mtrs before turning left for the HAFC clubhouse and parking area.

#### Accessible Car parking

There are 7 accessible spaces available immediately adjacent to the Main Entrance. Further spaces are also available in this vicinity. These surfaces are all tarmac. All spaces are based on a first come first served basis.

**NB:** Should all spaces be taken further parking is available behind the Clubhouse. The surface however is a combination of grass and gravel.

#### Stadium access

Entrance at the main gate is via a concreted and slabbed surface.

#### Accessible viewing

Turning right on entry to the stadium leads to a covered enclosure with an area set aside for mobility scooters, wheelchairs etc. Also, seating can be provided if necessary.

Further viewing is available if turning left on entry and utilising the pathway at the east end of the ground.

No ambulant seating is designated within the ground at present; however, a new 155 seat stand was erected in April 2025 and is now open for use. Ambulant seating will be provided in due course.

### Accessible Toilets

Turning left on entry from the main gate leads to the Clubhouse which houses the accessible toilet facility. Access is via a slabbed walkway.

#### **Catering**

No disabled counter is available at the catering hub; however, orders can be taken & delivered from the door off the facility.

### Ticketing:

Admission is charged at the full rate for wheelchair users and ambulant disabled supporters. admission for personal assistants is complementary

Circa season 2025/26 – Full rate £10.00, Concessions £5.00

Tickets can be purchased at the gate on the day of the match. Electronic payment is available.

Season Tickets are also available on request.
